

URGENT- The SYRIZA Government Forwarded Bill To Ban The Right Of Strike

The servants of the industrialists, the Government of SYRIZA-ANEL submitted yesterday evening, Monday, December 4, in the Greek Parliament, a legislation to impose new obstacles against the right of the workers and their unions to go on strike. That is when, with today's conditions, 99 out of 100 workers' strikes are called illegal!

The SYRIZA government, surpassing all its predecessors in shameful tactics, attempted to impose the specific legislation as an amendment to a bill about...Satellites!!

That was in order to avoid the reactions of the workers and the class unions. But SYRIZA, who like a fraud tried to fool the workers, failed.
